

# Acceptable Proof of Identity Documentation

## Two valid forms of identity are required to receive a government issued ID

(One valid form must be from the primary list)

### Primary Proof of Identity

U.S. Military ID card

Military Family Member's ID card

Driver's License or ID card issued by a state or outlying possession of the United States, provided it contains a photograph.

ID card issued by federal, state, or local government agencies or entities, provided it contains a photograph

U.S. Passport

Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt

### Card with Photograph

(INS Form I-151 or I-551)

Unexpired Temporary Resident Card

(INS Form I-688)

Unexpired Employment Authorization Card

(INS Form I-688A)

Unexpired Employment Authorization

Document issued by the INS that contains a photograph

(INS Form I-688B)

### Secondary Proof of Identity

U.S. Social Security identification card issued by the Social Security Administration

Original or Certified copy of a Birth Certificate issued by a state, county, municipal authority or outlying possession of the United States bearing an official seal

Certification of Birth Abroad issued by the Department of State

(Form FS-545 or Form DS-1350)

Foreign Passport

School ID with a photograph

Voter's Registration Card

Driver's License issued by a Canadian Government Authority

ID card for use of Resident Citizen in the United States

(INS Form I-179)

U.S. Citizen ID card

(INS Form I-197)

Certificate of U.S. Citizenship

(INS Form N-560 or N-561)

Certificate of Naturalization

(INS Form N-550 or N-570)

Unexpired Reentry Permits

(INS Form I-327)

Unexpired refugee Travel Document
