TESTING PROGRAM

College Level Examination Program (CLEP)

CLEP consists of a series of examinations that test an individual's college level knowledge. The general exams test for broad general knowledge while subject exams test for a specific depth of knowledge. Each exam is a 90-minute objective test. Subject CLEP optional Essays are timed 90-minute examinations. The CLEPs are generally at the freshman and sophomore level.

DANTES Subject Standardized Tests (DSST)

The DSST program is an extensive series of exams in college subject areas. Most tests are at the freshman and sophomore level of competency. All DSSTs, except Public Speaking oral section, are objective and have no time limit.

The Excelsior College Examinations (ECE)

Excelsior College Examinations are used to meet specific college degree requirements of the Excelsior College degrees. There are 40 undergraduate examinations in the subject areas of Arts & Science, Business, and Nursing. ECE objective tests are multiple choice, and ECE Extended response are essay type exams.

CLEP, DSST, and ECE Eligibility

Eligible active and reserve personnel may take the DSST, CLEP and ECE exams on a funded basis. An Army Education Center guidance counselor must first authorize all testing.

Other Exams

Eligible personnel may take the ACT, ECE Extended response exams, PRAXIS (NTE), and SAT when approved by an Army Education Center guidance counselor. Speak with your Education Center Army guidance counselor for more information on eligibility.

Study Materials

The Medal of Honor Post Library has study material for many of the exams listed above. Some materials can be borrowed. Study material is also available on Army Knowledge Online (My Library).

Army Personnel Testing (APT)

Eligible Army personnel may take the AFAST, AFCT, DLAB and DLPT when approved by the Commander.

Other Testing

Other tests include the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE), Pre-GT, Interest Tests (Strong Interest Inventory and College Placement). Tests can be scheduled for military correspondence courses and civilian correspondence/distance learning courses.

Test Fees

An EXAM requiring a FEE may be paid by MONEY ORDER. Checks may be used to pay a FEE for CLEP, ACT, ASE, SAT, and PRAXIS. Master Card or Visa may also be used to pay a FEE for DSSTs, ASE, SAT, and PRAXIS. Cash is not an available option. The FEE for an exam must be paid before the test is distributed and the test session begins. Active and reserve personnel may be responsible for FEES associated with exams such as ASE and PRAXIS.
