SUBJECT: Fort George G. Meade Policy Memorandum #66, Multi-Occupancy Vehicle (MOV) Access Pilot Program

1. References:

- a. AR 190-5, Motor Vehicle Traffic Supervision, dated 22 May 2006.
- b. FGGM Reg 190-5, Motor Vehicle Traffic Supervision, dated 5 May 2009.

2. Purpose. To provide an exclusive access point for personnel who carpool to FGGM.

3. Applicability. This policy is applicable to all personnel provided access to FGGM.

4. Policy. Beginning 3 January 2010, only vehicles which are occupied by two or more personnel may enter through the Llewellyn Avenue access control point on weekdays between the hours of 0600 and 0800. Vehicles attempting to enter this gate without two or more personnel will be turned around and directed to another access control point. All vehicles entering through this gate must be registered at the Demps Visitor Control Center and must have a DOD Decal displayed IAW AR 190-5 Motor Vehicle Supervision, dated 22 May 2006. This policy will be reevaluated after 60 days to determine if the MOV Pilot Program supports FGGM's goals for reduced Single Occupant Vehicle traffic in support of the Installation Traffic Demand Management Plan.

5. Proponent. The Directorate of Emergency Services is the proponent for this policy. Point of contact is the Director of Emergency Services at (301) 677-6029.
