MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Command Policy Memorandum #52, Physical Separation of Parties
Involved in Family Violence

1. Domestic violence poses a clear threat to the safety and welfare of the members of our military community. The greater the crisis and risk to our service members and their Families, the greater the need to move quickly, focusing on the safety and protection of the people involved.
2. The Fort George G. Meade designated reporting point of contact for domestic violence incidents is the Directorate of Emergency Services at (301) 677-6622.
3. Unit Commanders will take the actions listed on the enclosed, Domestic Violence Checklist, when they become aware of an allegation of domestic violence involving a member of their command. All Commanders will sign the checklist, maintain the original copy in the Soldier's counseling file, and forward a copy to their unit trial counsel.
4. The actions listed on the checklist are the minimum required of Commanders. Nothing in this policy memorandum precludes a Commander from taking any other appropriate lawful action. These protective measures are designed to safeguard members of the military community while the case is assessed by the Family Advocacy Program (FAP), investigated by legal authorities, and when appropriate, adjudicated through administrative or judicial processes.
