MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Fort George G. Meade (FGGM) Policy Memorandum # 62, Temporary Suspension, Termination, or Denial of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation (FMWR) Patronage Privilege.

1. The purpose of this memorandum is to establish policy and procedure governing temporary suspension, termination, revocation, or denial of patronage privileges at FGGM FMWR activities and facilities.
2. Reference: Army Regulation 215-1, Military Morale, Welfare and Recreation Programs and Non-appropriated Fund Instrumentalities, 24 September 2010.
3. As the Garrison Commander, I have the authority to suspend, terminate or deny FMWR patronage privileges if it is in the best interest of the activity, the program, the installation, or the Army AR 215-1, paragraph 7-4b-c, lists examples of abuses that may result in suspension or termination of privileges. This list is by no means exhaustive and only reflects examples of actions that by their very nature are illegal such as stealing or presenting bad checks and therefore, reflect poorly on the good order and discipline of the installation.
4. Alleged abuses that may warrant suspension, termination or revocation of privileges will be investigated using procedures described in AR 215-1, paragraph 18-3. AR 15-6, Procedures for Investigating Officers and Boards of Officers, 2 October 2006 will also be used for more serious and formal investigations. Alleged perpetrators will be given time to review the charges and respond.
5. The length of the suspension or denial of privileges will reflect the seriousness of the infraction, but in no case will exceed 30 calendar days. Examples of minor infractions include, but are not limited to the following:
 - a. Profane language or un-sportsman-like conduct in all FMWR facilities or on sports fields.
 - b. Disrupting play at the bowling center.
 - c. Entering a facility while under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs.

- d. Violations of pet care center boarder agreements.
- e. Returning rental equipment dirty or late.

6. Facility or activity managers will report all temporary suspensions or denials of service to the Director of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation immediately. If feasible, they will include the name and telephone number of the patron in the report as well as the circumstances of the infraction and their rationale for the length of the temporary suspension. Patrons who have been temporarily suspended or denied service may ask the Director of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation to review the circumstances. Suspension or denial of privileges for longer than 30 days requires the decision of the Garrison Commander.

This is a Notice of Temporary Suspension, Termination, or Denial of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation (FMWR) Patronage Privileges.

Pursuant to Fort George G. Meade (FGGM) Policy Memorandum #62, Temporary Suspension, Termination or Denial of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation (FMWR) Patronage Privilege, you are suspended from entering the FMWR facility listed below. This suspension is effective upon your receipt of this letter, and will remain in effect for 30 calendar days.

This temporary suspension is based on evidence that you created a disturbance in the facility, or knowingly made malicious statements against an employee of the facility, and failure to observe and follow rules and regulations pertaining to closing times at the facility resulting in staff working beyond their scheduled shift.

As the Garrison Commander, it is my inherent duty to maintain good order and discipline and to ensure a safe environment for everyone that resides and works on the installation. The substance of the allegations cause me great concern, therefore you are not permitted to use the following facility listed below for 30 days:
