DFMWR – BOD Healthy Base Initiative

- Fort Meade is 1 of 14 pilot sites (DoD wide) chosen to participate in the Healthy Base Initiative (HBI). Part of Operation Live Well, its Vision is “A system and culture that improves readiness while lowering cost by reducing obesity and tobacco use”.
- **Demonstration project scheduled to conclude in June 2015.**
- **Share our Strengths (SOS):** After the HBI demonstration program ends in June, SOS is able to continue providing CMATS grocery tours at the commissary. This will be at no cost to Fort Meade, using SOS volunteers to provide the service. The tours will take on a different format, and no longer offer a \$10 grocery coupon.
- **Alliance for a Healthier Generation:** The contract with Alliance for a Healthier Generation has ended. Based on final site visit, Pershing Hill Elementary and Meade Heights Elementary will be applying for the Alliance for a Healthier Generation National Recognition Award, at the Bronze level. If selected, it will be included on the application for the MD Wellness School of Distinction.
- **24-Hour Fitness:** Access to Murphy Field house 24 / 7 with CAC. The request for proposal has been submitted to Contracting for bid.
- **WellBeats:** The WellBeats system arrived April 9, 2015. WellBeats is a virtual group fitness platform with fitness programming and written programs to guide participants towards the results they are looking for. At the touch screen kiosk users can view studio schedules, browse through the library of classes, and initiate classes on-demand.
- **Farmers’ Market:** The 2nd Annual Fort Meade’s Farmers’ Market is scheduled to begin June 10 and run through Sept. 9 The Market will be held every Wednesday from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. at the Pavilion. Working with NSA reps on potential partnership for Farmer’s Markets.




