

Anne Arundel and Howard Counties, in partnership with the City of Laurel and Northern Prince George's County, are conducting the Central Maryland TDP. The City of Annapolis and Prince George's County will be conducting their own plans separately.

What is a Transit Development Plan?

A Transit Development Plan (TDP) serves as a guide for public transit services over the next five years. It provides a roadmap for implementing service and organizational improvements, including potential service expansion.

Elements of the plan include:

- Identifying public and specialized transportation needs of the service area
- Analyzing the performance of existing transit services
- Exploring alternatives for improving services
- Recommending implementation plan including a 5-year budget

Who will be affected by the plan?

This plan is for the whole Central Maryland community. The recommended service improvements will impact both current transit riders and potential new riders, and all the places they need to go including work, school, medical centers, and shopping and recreational destinations.

What is the project schedule?

We are conducting the system evaluation and public engagement activities to identify transit needs and issues from October-December 2016. In early 2017 service alternatives will be ready for review and feedback. The draft and final plans will be developed from March-July 2017.

How can I get involved?

There are many ways to provide your input on future public transit services in Central Maryland:

- Attend a public meeting (see project website for details)

 - ♦ Second round planned for February 2017 to review service alternatives
- Complete a community survey or a rider survey
 - ♦ Available on project website in October & November 2016
 - ♦ Rider survey to be distributed on RTA buses by November 2016


